United Way supports AACs programs



The United Way of the Ohio Valley supports the three AmeriCorps Seniors programs and the Early Head Start program here at Audubon Area Community Services, Inc. The Foster Grandparent Program, RSVP, and Senior Companion Program are three federal volunteer programs for individuals aged 55+, yet the community at large also benefits from their service. AmeriCorps Seniors Foster Grandparents are assigned to serve children in Head Start and elementary schools that need extra individualized attention in order to succeed academically, developmentally, and/or socially. AmeriCorps Seniors RSVP volunteers serve in local nonprofits that focus on health, education, housing, and economic opportunity. AmeriCorps Seniors-Senior Companions serve in private homes of the area's most frail

and vulnerable elderly to promote independent living skills or to provide respite for caregivers. Funds through the United Way of the Ohio Valley support mandated volunteer benefits such as stipends, transportation, insurance, meals, training, criminal background checks, and recognition. Volunteers from all three AmeriCorps Seniors programs comment on the financial security found in reimbursements or stipends (Foster Grandparents/Senior Companions).

"It helps pay my light bill. It helps with the cost of gas. I can buy groceries."

Volunteer service helps to maintain or improve physical and/or mental health.

"It gets me out of the house. It gives me something to do. It gives me a purpose."

"It's so nice to be acknowledged" one RSVP volunteer commented after receiving a certificate thanking her for 20 years of service.

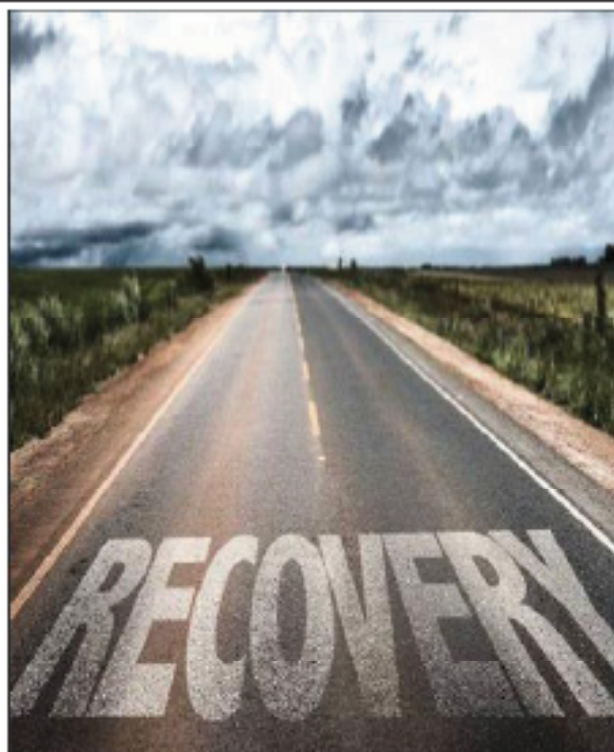

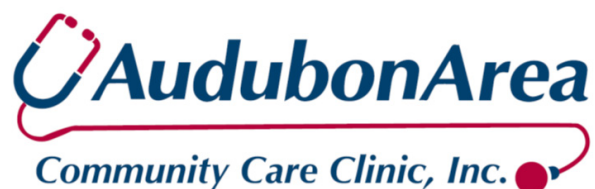

Halloween 2021 is fast approaching and COVID concerns during celebrations are on everyone's mind. Here are some tips and information for safe celebrating in 2021 from the National Safety Council.

Kids love the magic of Halloween, but the COVID-19 pandemic means Halloween may be a bit different this year. You can still have fun! First and foremost, follow the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's guidelines to ensure your celebrations are safe.

If trick-or-treating is allowed in your area, follow these & other CDC recommended simple steps. Of course, costume & traffic safety measures still apply.

Costume Safety

To help ensure adults and children have a safe holiday, the American Academy of Pediatrics has compiled a list of Halloween safety tips. Before Halloween arrives, be sure to choose a costume that won't cause safety hazards.

- All costumes, wigs and accessories should be fire-resistant
- If children are allowed out after dark, fasten reflective tape to their costumes and bags, or give them glow sticks
- When buying Halloween makeup, make sure it is nontoxic and always

test it in a small area first

- Remove all makeup before children go to bed to prevent skin and eye irritation

When They're on the Prowl

Here's a scary statistic: Children are more than twice as likely to be hit by a car and killed on Halloween than on any other day of the year. Lack of visibility because of low lighting at night also plays a factor in these incidents.

Keep these tips in mind when your children are out on Halloween night:

- A responsible adult should accompany young children on the neighborhood rounds
- If your older children are going alone, plan and review a route acceptable to you
- Agree on a specific time children should return home
- Teach your children never to enter a stranger's home or car
- Instruct children to travel only in familiar, well-lit areas and stick with their friends
- Tell your children not to eat any treats until they return home
- Children and adults are reminded to put electronic devices down, keep heads up and walk, don't run, across the street

Safety Tips for Motorists

NSC offers these additional safety tips for parents - and anyone who plans to be on the road during trick-or-treat hours:

- Watch for children walking on roadways, medians and curbs
- Enter and exit driveways and alleys carefully
- At twilight and later in the evening, watch for children in dark clothing
- Discourage new, inexperienced drivers from driving on Halloween
