## 20,000 Masks Donated in Owensboro

UniFirst and The Daviess County Fiscal Court each donated 10,000 masks to the Audubon Area Community Services on Tuesday, Sept. 29th. The masks will be distributed to volunteers who work in soup kitchens, schools and other outreach programs. “As markets are beginning to reopen and communities are getting ready to reopen during this changeling time, this is one of those items -- masks, disposable masks that is maybe not as readily available in the community right now,” said Bethany Johnson, customer service manager with UniFirst. “So, that need was a perfect fit for us to jump on board with our local community and with Daviess County Fiscal Court to meet that need.” And the Daviess County Commissioners are grateful they are able to help out with this partnership and make sure those in the community get the masks they need. And it’s all thanks to new grant money. “Well it makes sense, because there’s a real need. And we have the ability to do it,” said Daviess County Commissioner George Wathen. “And we wanted to make sure that they knew we appreciated what they do for our community — so we decided to match.” While Brandon Harley, the deputy chief executive officer with the Audubon Area Community Services, said this donation is essential to many of their volunteers, as they rely on limited grant funds to operate. “Whenever this crisis event occurred, we

didn’t have the budget in place already to deal with the large amount of PPE, the masking, the hand sanitization, the gloves, all of those things,” Harley said. “So, we had to scramble quite a bit. And a donation like this from a community partner really allows us to do the great work that Audubon area does in the community.”

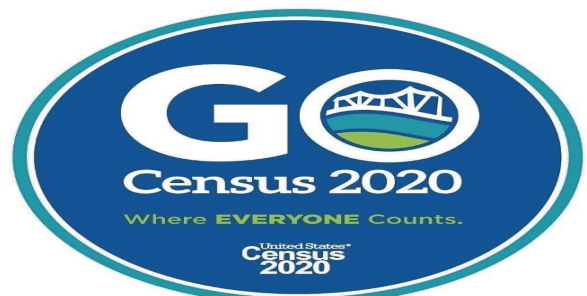

## **AUDUBON PROGRAM QUIZ**

- 1: \_\_\_\_\_ provides opportunities and workshops for individuals wanting to improve their job performance, significantly contribute to their professional development and even industry specific training is available.
- 2: \_\_\_\_\_ Program Participants must be at least 55 years of age, unemployed, and have a family income of no more than 125% of the federal poverty level.
- 3: \_\_\_\_\_ is to assist communities in reducing poverty, revitalizing low-income communities and empowering low-income families to become self-sufficient.
- 4: \_\_\_\_\_ is a program that provides support and training for the Affordable Care Act.
- 5: \_\_\_\_\_ puts volunteers in elementary and Head Start classrooms with at-risk and special needs children to enhance learning.
- 6: \_\_\_\_\_ provides opportunities for seniors to use their knowledge and life experiences to help meet local critical needs by volunteering at many diverse non-profit organizations.
- 7: \_\_\_\_\_ is a volunteer program for low-income seniors to aid the homebound elderly and encourage independent living in an effort to prevent or delay institutionalization.
- 8: \_\_\_\_\_ This group of programs provides families with the knowledge and ability to maintain a safe and healthy family unit, thereby preventing out of home placements for the children.

10: \_\_\_\_\_ an elderly and special needs complex, is located at 2220 East 18th Street, Owensboro. The project consists of 34 2-bedroom units.

11: \_\_\_\_\_ has provided a bridge to Career Pathway approach to unsubsidized employment in 34 counties since 2007 by combining time-limited subsidized employment with a comprehensive set of services to help participants overcome barriers and build work-related skills.

12: Audubon Area Community Services \_\_\_\_\_ enables low-income households to reside in houses that are energy efficient and lower their utility bills.

13: \_\_\_\_\_ assists low-income households with home energy costs

14: \_\_\_\_\_ providing access to affordable health care. *Wide array of health care and related services* such as physical examinations, office and laboratory testing, or immunizations (limited). AACCC provides referral services for behavioral counseling, dental care, or other health care specialties.

15: \_\_\_\_\_ Providing Transportation Services in partnership with: The Department for Medicaid Services, Office for the Blind, Public Transportation, Veterans, and Vocational Rehabilitation.

16: \_\_\_\_\_ provides comprehensive early childhood services for eligible children. All children are provided a safe, nurturing environment in which they are given the opportunity to learn and experience success, with additional services provided to children with special needs.

17: \_\_\_\_\_ provides books at no charge to recipient families with children younger than age 5 with a vision to build a strong literacy foundation that will foster more proficient learning throughout each child's life.

## It's Open Enrollment Time!



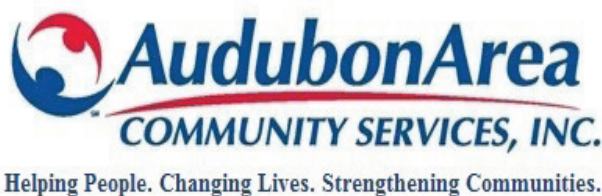
### Audubon Area Community Service 2020 Benefits Open Enrollment

**It is that time again!** The agency's open enrollment period for health, vision, dental, voluntary life, and supplemental insurance is **coming up in October/November 2020**. All staff will need to review Open Enrollment information to make plan option elections including plan coverage, new enrollment, and any changes to coverage such as adding dependents to plan(s) and/or dropping dependents who are no longer eligible for coverage. Any elections or changes must be made **before open enrollment ends 11/13/2020**. All elections/changes will be effective **January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021**. *Typically, changes throughout the year cannot be accepted unless a **qualifying event** occurs (birth/adoption of child, marriage, loss of coverage, etc).*

*Please note: Open enrollment is also a good time to review beneficiaries and make any changes there as well.*

Please watch your Audubon Area email for the open enrollment forms needed to make elections and/or changes to your benefit elections for the 2021 plan year. Open Enrollment information will be distributed via email and outlining the specifics for informational meetings, enrollment instructions, and a link to watch an open enrollment overview online. There will also be a payroll stuffer outlining important Open Enrollment information.
